



## **Cantimer Incorporated Establishes Partnership for Research on Hydration and Health with Danone Research**

Cantimer will also benefit from Danone's broad market knowledge and global reach as well as financial support to enable additional application development, clinical studies and scale-up activities.

"We have been collaborating with Danone on clinical studies for some time now", commented Robin Stracey, Cantimer's CEO. "This new agreement reflects the success of that collaboration and consolidates and extends the relationship. Danone's focus on hydration and health is very consistent with our own and the Company's expertise, financial support and global reach will greatly enhance our ability to fully capitalize on the commercial potential of our devices".

Under the agreement, Danone Research will assume a seat on Cantimer's Board and a Joint Development Team will be created to further scope out and manage product, application and clinical study plans prior to the anticipated commercialization of Cantimer's devices in 2011.
